First and foremost, I wish to appreciate the Board of Trustees, the General Executive Committee, fellowship leaders, and all members of WESO for their continued commitment towards the mission of evangelizing the Western region of Kenya. Your dedication and sacrifice have greatly contributed to the growth and impact of the ministry.

During the year, the Western Region was privileged to organize and participate in several successful spiritual activities aimed at strengthening fellowship among members and advancing the gospel ministry.

One of the major achievements realized was the successful regional retreat held at Masinde Muliro University. The retreat brought together students, alumni, and other ministry members from different fellowships within the region. The event provided a platform for spiritual nourishment, mentorship, worship, prayer, and strengthening unity among members. Many participants testified of spiritual renewal and encouragement through the retreat.

There is therefore need for increased sensitization and mobilization to encourage members to register and actively participate in the affairs of the ministry.

Another challenge observed is low participation in welfare matters, especially during bereavements and times when members require support. Strengthening the welfare department and encouraging members to stand together during difficult moments remains an area that requires more attention going forward.

As we look ahead, the region remains committed to strengthening fellowship coordination, increasing evangelistic activities, enhancing member participation, and supporting the vision and mission of WESO. We also aim at strengthening collaboration between students and non-student fellowships for continuity and sustainability of the ministry.

In conclusion, I sincerely thank all leaders and members for their prayers, cooperation, and commitment throughout the year. May God continue blessing WESO and enabling us to faithfully fulfill the Great Commission in the Western region and beyond.
